

Table of charges for CEWC-Cymru workshops and training

Note on fees: Where fees apply, we charge for the amount of time spent teaching at your school/college (including waiting time between lessons), rounded up to the nearest half hour. Fees are set at a rate which covers staff preparation and travelling time, so we do not usually make additional charges for these.

Note on expenses: In addition to any fees, we charge expenses as follows:

- (a) *Travel expenses* (the cheapest practical form of transport available, using rail/bus if possible) and
 (b) *Accommodation/subsistence* if an overnight stay is necessary (we aim to keep this to under £60 per night).
