CEWC-Cymru can provide training at any primary school, secondary school or college in Wales - as well as to local education authorities, advisory services and school clusters. Courses can last from an hour to 2 days, depending on your requirements, and we now offer two options for planning your course.

Training fees

CEWC-Cymru Affiliate Member school/college:

£420 per full school day or £85 / hour

P4C Level 1 course: £1,040 for 2 days

Non-member schools, LEAs and others:

£500 per full school day or £100 / hour

P4C Level 1 course: £1,200 for 2 days

Reduced rates available for joint teacher-student courses. Travel expenses are payable in all cases.

Philosophy for Children

FOUNDATION PHASE KEY STAGE 2

Philosophy for Children (P4C) is an approach that helps to develop young people's critical and creative thinking skills. We can train you to lead pupils' enquiries into ethics, justice, human nature and other philosophical topics.

- Level 1 accredited training course**
 A 2-day course which provides a full introduction to P4C. The course can be tailored to primary or secondary teachers. Trainees receive a certificate and handbook from SAPERE, the body that promotes P4C across the UK.
- One-day introductory course**
 This course considers the links between Thinking Skills (including P4C) and the delivery of global citizenship education.
- Shorter sessions**
 Introductory P4C sessions of any length – including demonstration lessons with students – can be delivered after school or in conjunction with advisory bodies.
